**Vetting:** by Committee. Check-in times:

**Trial 1:** 7.30am - 8.00am **Trial 2:** 10.30am - 10.45am **Trial 3:** 1.00pm - 1.15pm

**Trial 4:** 8.00am - 8.30am **Trial 5:** Finalists posted.

Bitches without proof of de-sexing only. All dogs to pass through the Checkpoint by close.

Dogs only to be registered or vetted before their first Trial. Same competitor numbers for both days.

**Safety:** All exhibitors shall abide by the Agility Safety Guidelines and National Agility Rules 2021. All exhibitors shall adhere to the Covid 19 Plan.

**Finals:** Only qualifiers in Novice, Excellent and Masters will be eligible to compete in the Agility and Jumping Finals, EXCEPT that judges for the Qualifying Heats will be given automatic entry into the Finals providing they enter and handle that dog in the other two Qualifying Heats. Dogs only have to qualify for the Agility and Jumping Finals once.

**Teams Challenge (Open Jumping):** Groups of 4 people can nominate to form a team. All team members must enter in Open Jumping in Trial 4. Each team member will complete their JDO run as per the catalogue and will be scored as per normal. The top 3 runs for each team will be compiled and the team with the least faults wins. In the event of teams having equal results, the team with the fastest combined time will win.

**Team Eligibility Criteria:** Of the 4 dog-and-handler team members, only 2 of the dogs may have a JDM or JDO title. The other 2 dogs must be untitled in both JDM and JDO. Additionally, at least 2 heights must be represented in a team.

**Juniors Event:** Handlers who are 7 years to less than 18 years of age are invited to compete in two Junior Novice Jumping events (in Trials 4 and 5). Scores from the two runs will be combined. The handler with the least faults will be the winner. In the event of competitors having equal results, the handler with the fastest combined time will win. One winner across all heights; not height-specific. Note: Neither dogs nor handlers must compete in the regular JD class in Trials 4 and 5.

**Veterans Event (NFC):** A demonstration event for dogs 8 year and over that have retired from competitive events.

**Entry Fee:** \$10.00 per class; Juniors \$10.00 only (covers both Trials 4 & 5).

**Teams Event:** No additional cost – register during vetting on Saturday morning.

**Veterans:** Veterans free – register during Sunday morning vetting time; a maximum of 12 dogs on a first come basis; one run per dog.

Cash payments for the correct amount can be handed direct to Chloe Dunlop or deposited in a dedicated box at trials; Note: cash payments must be accompanied by entry forms or copy of k9entries entry forms.

**Incorrect or incomplete entries,** or entries without the correct fees, will be returned. The onus is on the entrant to submit correct and complete entries prior to the advertised close of entries. **Late entries will not be accepted.** Paper entries postmarked after the closing date will not be accepted.

A stamped self-addressed envelope is required if acknowledgement of entry is requested.

**Finals: Prizes and rosettes for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Place qualifiers in each Class**

**Trophies: Games, Opens and Jumping & Agility Finals – 1<sup>st</sup> Place qualifiers in each Class**

**Juniors: Trophy for 1<sup>st</sup> place qualifier; Prizes 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Place qualifiers**

**Teams Event: Prizes 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Place qualifiers**

**State Champion Status** will only be awarded to the highest place qualifier in the Finals in each Class.

**Qualification Cards:** Provided for Agility and Jumping Heats, Games and Opens; not Finals.

**Sashes:** Available on request.

**Finals' Presentations: Games** on Saturday; **Agility & Jumping, Juniors and Teams** will be on Sunday and will not commence until all the equipment is packed away.
